It is the mission of the Family and Consumer Sciences Program to enable all students to develop competence, compassion and fulfillment in managing their personal, family and career lives.



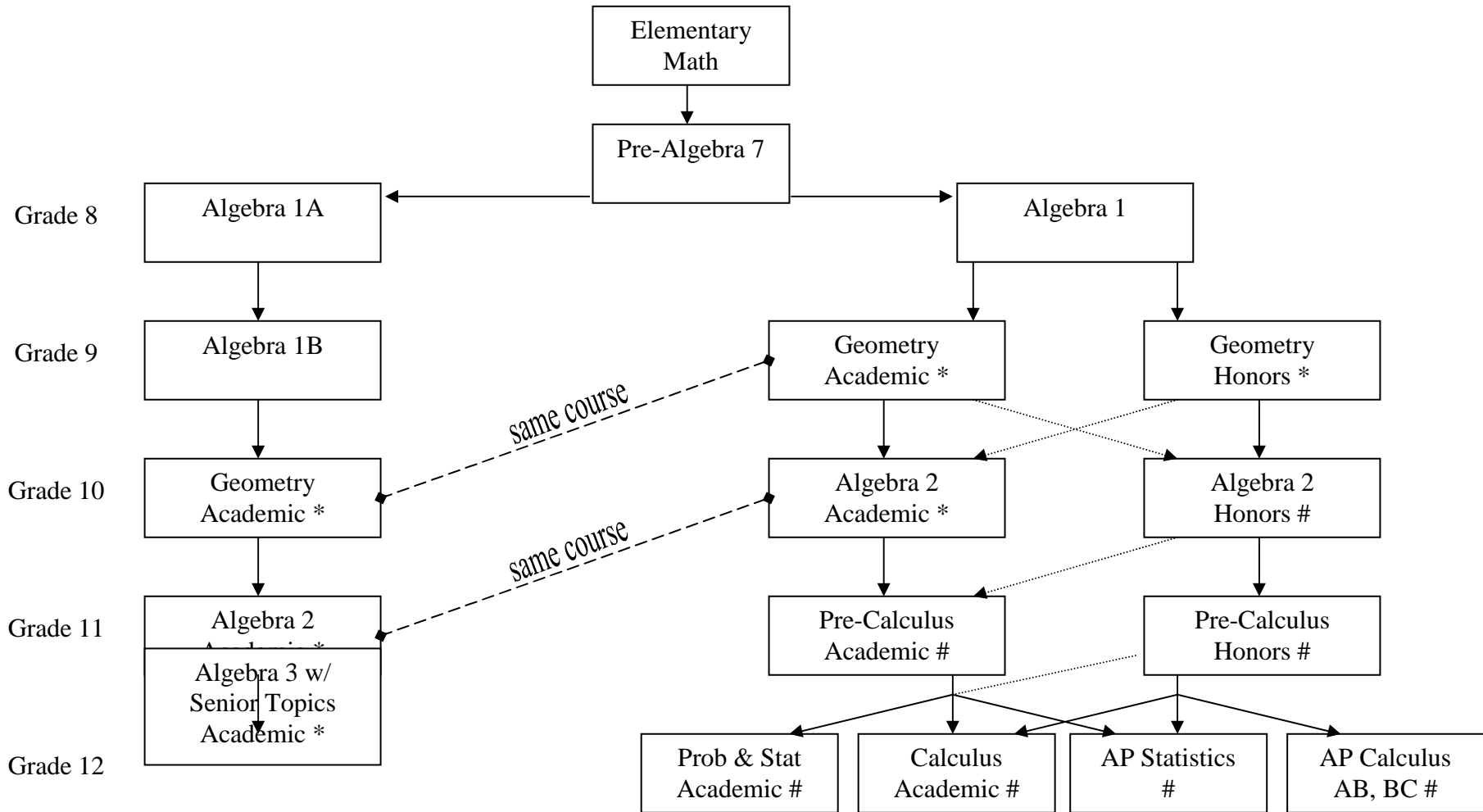

## *Math Course Sequence*

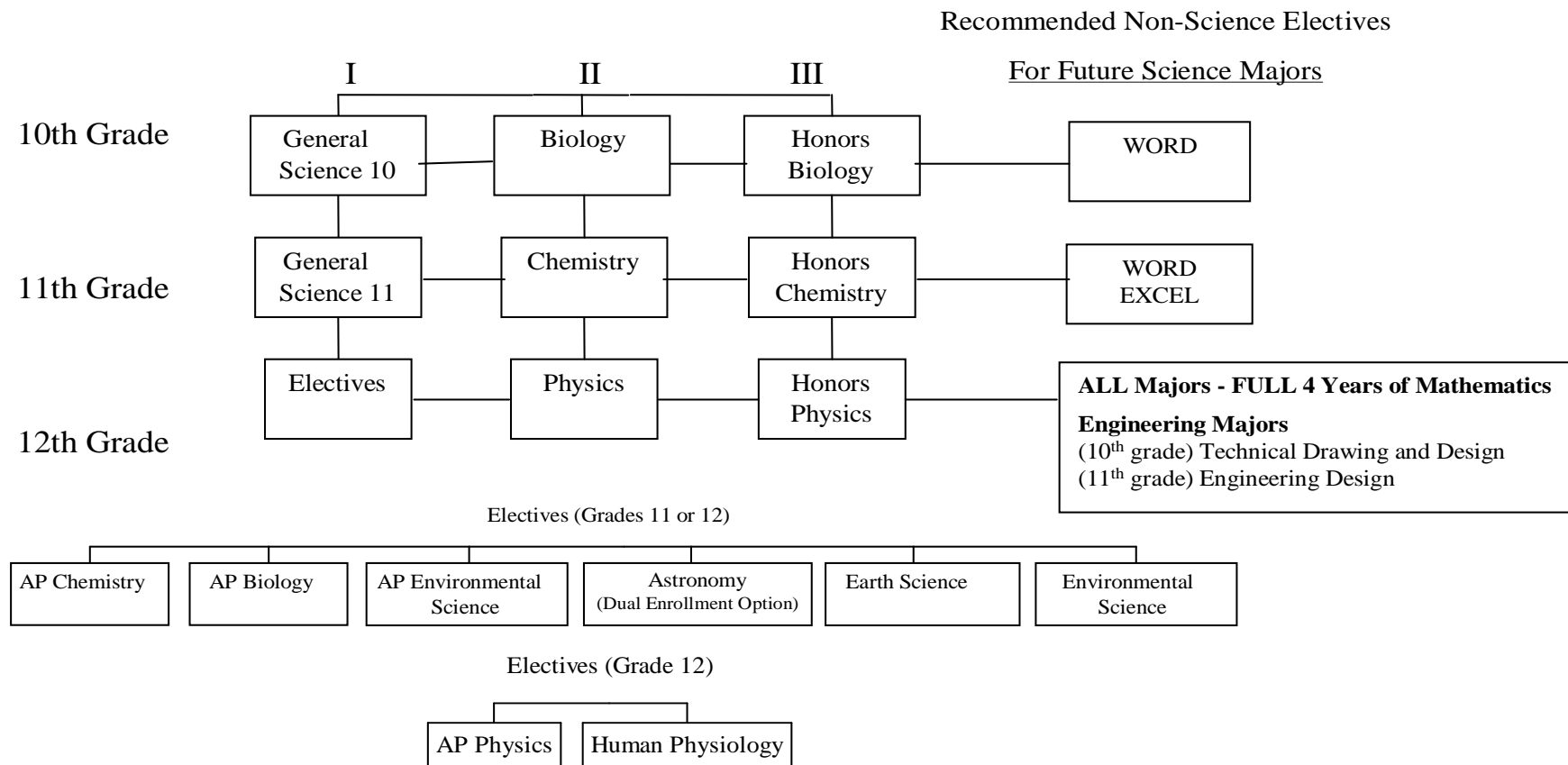

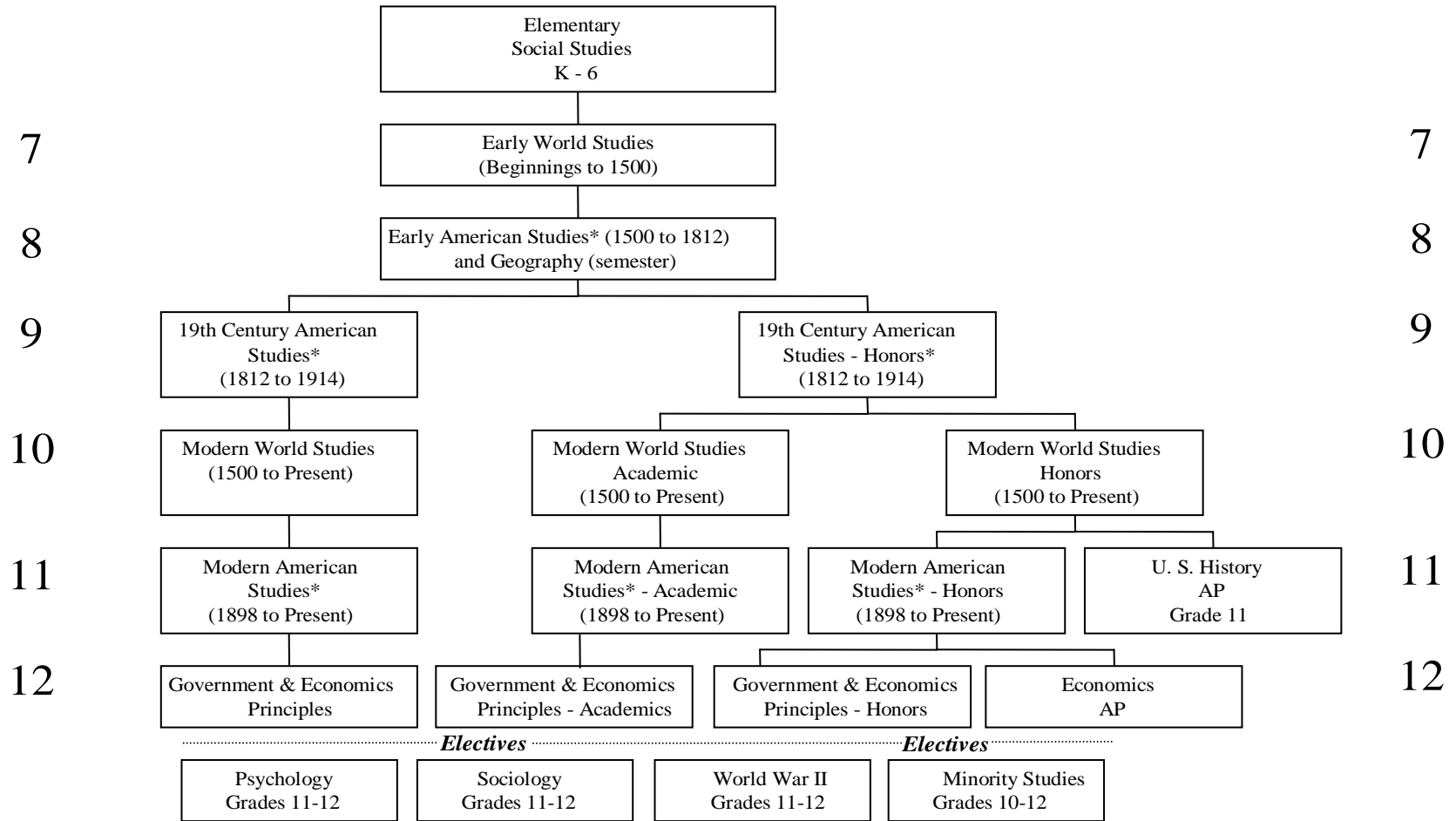
