Re: Asbestos Management Plan – Senior High School

Dear Parents, Teachers and Residents of the Boyertown Area School District:

The Boyertown Area School District is providing notification that the asbestos management plan is available for review by all interested parties. In order to see the asbestos management plan please contact the office of your local school and make arrangements to review the management plan in the office.

Boyertown Area School District has been diligent in removing asbestos containing materials. With each building renovation where appropriate, all detected asbestos containing building materials have been removed.

The Senior High School has four areas that contain asbestos:

1. Floor tile under display case in Room 410 Instrumental Music.
2. Insulation on pipes in chases unopened during renovations.
3. Transite Panel fireproofing steel support in Administration Offices, Room 405.
4. Floor tile in three story building, Rooms 209 and 210.

These areas are inspected twice a year to verify that the material remains non-friable.

This past summer the Boyertown Area School District completed the three-year asbestos re-inspection mandated by the EPA. Environmental concerns within the Boyertown Area School District buildings remain the highest priority to enhance the learning environment and health and safety of our students and staff.
