Dear Parents/Guardians:

BASH will be extending its early dismissal privilege to now include a late arrival privilege for qualifying students in grades 10, 11, and 12. Students needing to utilize the normally scheduled morning bus transportation are not eligible to apply for this privilege. Students attending AM Berks Career and Technology Center classes are also not eligible to apply for this privilege as they will need to board busses for BCTC at the regularly scheduled time.

Approval for this privilege is based on continued sound academic progress and continued good attendance and discipline records. Privileges can be suspended/removed at any time for changes in the students' status.

Students participating in the late arrival portion of the late arrival/early dismissal privilege will need to sign in at the attendance office located directly across from the high school main office upon entering the building before proceeding to his/her second period class. Students failing to sign in may compromise continuation of this privilege.

Students will also be responsible for checking the grade level bins located in the high attendance office for information that may have been distributed during homeroom.

Students need to be cognizant that they may miss important announcements that are usually provided via BASH TV news in the morning during homeroom. It is for this reason that students and their parents are encouraged to access the daily announcements through accessing the following link:
