3. **Philanthropic Education Organization Scholarship**

Amount: \$2,500

Criteria:

- 1) Must be a female senior in high school
- 2) Minimum GPA of 3.00
- 3) U.S. or Canadian citizen
- 4) Planning to attend a post-secondary school in the United States or Canada
- 5) Two letters of reference
- 6) Student essay
- 7) Official transcript

5. **John McKee Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000 for a vocational award, \$2,500 college award

Criteria:

- 1) Be a fatherless boy native to Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery or Philadelphia County
- 2) Official SAT score report
- 3) Official transcript
- 4) Principal’s evaluation

Deadline: February 1, 2010

6. **Pottstown Garden Club**

Amount: 2 - \$1,000

Criteria:

- 1) Pursue a career in a horticulture related field
- 2) Strong academic record
- 3) Volunteer/service work and extra-curricular activities

Deadline: December 11, 2009

7. **KFC Scholars Scholarship**

Amount: Up to \$5,000 a year

Criteria: 1) Graduate from high school this school year
2) Have a minimum GPA of 2.75
3) Enroll in a public, in-state college or university
4) Pursue a bachelor's degree
5) Be a U.S. Citizen

7) Students will have to compose some short answers to various questions

Amount: \$500 to \$7,500

Criteria: 1) Information and application is available on the following website gwcf.org

9. **Hugh Carcella United Steelworkers Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000/year for four years (6 available)

Criteria: 1) Be a son or daughter of a member of the United Steelworkers
2) Be pursuing a Bachelor's Degree
3) Grades and SAT scores
4) Interview
5) Application may be obtained from participating local unions

Deadline: March 15, 2010

10. **Young Entrepreneur Award**

Amount: \$1,000 to 10,000

Criteria: 1) Senior who will be attending a two or four year college, or vocational institute in the Fall of 2010
2) Student will demonstrate entrepreneurial spirit by starting his/her own business or participating in such organizations as DECA, Junior Achievement, or FBLA
3) Transcript with SAT scores, GPA, and class rank
4) Apply on-line www.NFIB.com/YEA and click on "Apply Now"

Deadline: December 31, 2009

11. Pennsylvania State Employee Credit Union (PSECU) Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000 (6 scholarships available)

Criteria: 1) Must be a member of the PSECU by December 24, 2009
2) Call 1-800-237-7328 for a scholarship application

12. Slush Puppy Scholarship Essay Competition

Amount: \$1,000

Criteria: 1. High school senior
2. Student is planning to attend a college/university or trade school in Fall of 2010
3. Complete application
4. 300 word (or more) essay question

Deadline: April 15, 2010

13. American Welding Society Scholarship

Amount: \$500 - \$1,500

Criteria: 1) Must be enrolled in a welding-related education or training program
2) Must be graduating high school or possess a GED equivalent
3) School you are attending must be in the United States/US territories
4) Must be a member of the American Welding Society (will receive a yearlong full membership to the society if awarded the scholarship)
5) Must fill out scholarship application

Deadline: March 1, 2010

14. Council on Chemical Abuse

Amount: \$1,000

Criteria: 1) Must be a Berks County Junior or Senior
2) Must complete application form
3) Must include two letters of recommendation
4) Must send an unofficial school transcript
5) Must complete a 1000 word (or less) biographical statement on one of the prompts provided

Deadline: March 5, 2010

15. **AXA Achievement Community Scholarship**

Amount: \$2,000

Criteria:

- 1) Must be a United States Citizen or legal resident
- 2) Must be a current high school senior planning to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college or university by Fall 2010
- 3) Must have evidence of outstanding achievement in school, community, or work related activities
- 4) Must be recommended by an unrelated adult who can attest to student's achievement
- 5) Must fill out the application found at www.axa-achievement.com

Deadline: February 15, 2010

16. **Ronald McDonald House Charities**

Amount: Minimum of \$1,000

Criteria:

- 1) Must have at least one parent of Hispanic Heritage
- 2) Must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year school in the Fall
- 3) Must be a legal United States Resident
- 4) Must have at least a 2.7 cumulative GPA
- 5) Must include a transcript and letter of recommendation
- 6) Must complete the application and a personal statement
- 7) Must include a copy of parents' IRS 1040 Form

Deadline: February 16, 2010

17. **Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships**

Amount: \$300 - \$1,000

Criteria:

- 1) Must be enrolled in a degree program in an accredited American Institute of post-secondary education
- 2) Must complete a 500 word essay on given prompt
- 3) Must be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa
- 4) Need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa

Deadline: January 15, 2010

18. **Pennsylvania Association of Community Bankers**

Amount: \$1,000 annual, renewable scholarship

Criteria:

- 1) Must be the child of an employee of a PACB institution
- 2) Must be a high school graduate
- 3) Must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college or university
- 4) Must maintain a certain GPA in college
