The minutes from the committee meeting of 9/5/13 were moved by Mrs. Semmens, second by Dr. Christman. The minutes were adopted unanimously.

KCBA Architects and D'Huy Engineering provided an update on the Boyertown Area Senior High School construction project, reviewing items addressed over the last week. The first project team meeting was held the afternoon of September 17 followed by a meeting with the design team. At the design team meeting, the new professional team introduced themselves and updated the group on the changes that occurred over the summer and the current state of the project. There was discussion about the design team and the members. The LEED Certification and the process was discussed. The bus planning and the traffic study were discussed and several members questioned the projected square footage and their concern over room utilization. John Hartman from D'Huy Engineering, distributed and reviewed a tentative calendar of meetings and dates leading up to the November 12, 2013 meeting. Public Comment Period #2

Mr. Hugh Kelly talked about the use of the old three story building. He expressed his appreciation for the inclusion of the building in the new plan, but stated he would like to volunteer to serve on a committee to assist in bringing the old building up to code and usable for education purposes.

She posed questions on the size of the additions and student capacity, as well as the proposed number of academies.
