BASH Water and Field Watering

Currently there are two waterlines coming into the BASH Complex:

- Line 1 feeds Bear Stadium and is used for bathrooms, concession stand, water fountains and other general use for the concession stand.
- Line 2 feeds the rest of the BASH complex including Memorial Stadium.

Field Watering:

Traditionally, the only fields that get watered are the baseball and football field at Bear Stadium and Memorial Stadium.

Bears Stadium Field:

- Watered using a well that was drilled by the Boyertown Legion
- Small electric cost for running the well pump

Memorial Stadium Field

- Watered using a water cannon that is hooked up to city water
- The field is watered based on weather conditions.
- In a typical summer the field could be watered once/week for 16 hours.
- Approximate water usage based on the 30 gallons per minute is 28,800 gallons per watering
- Assuming 13 weeks of watering, this would be 374,400 gallons per summer.
- Based on current billing, this would come at a cost of \$5,957 per summer.
 - Note: At the present time, we do not have a dedicated water meter to track the water usage. We are working with the water authority to have a dedicated water meter added to this line.
