About the BASH Choirs

CURRICULAR CHOIRS

Concert Choir: The Concert Choir is an 11th and 12 grade "auditioned" group that meets every day during 2nd period. It currently has 95 members and is divided Soprano, Tenor, Alto, and Bass. It performs for local school events and community functions. The choir sings intermediate to advanced repertoire, which includes classical and popular music. All members are eligible to audition for county and district choirs.

Mixed Chorale: The Mixed Chorale meets every day during periods 4 or 6. The Mixed Chorale currently has 120 singers and includes 9th, 10th, and 11th graders. The Mixed Chorale performs SATB literature at the winter, spring concert, and at Songs for Hope.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR CHOIRS

Show Choir: The BASH Show Choir is an auditioned group for advanced singers in 10th- 12th grade. Rehearsals are Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:30pm in the choir room. Repertoire includes advanced choir music, as well as crossover pieces (Jazz, Broadway, and Pop) literature. The group performs for the community throughout the year, as well at the Winter and Spring Concert. The district activity fee applies to this ensemble. Singers in Show Choir must participate in Concert Choir.

Select Singers: The BASH Select Singers is an auditioned group open to 9th-12th graders. We rehearse every day during Flex and an occasional after school rehearsal. Students in select singers may participate in other activities during Flex including remediation, however, I expect to see the singers at least 1-2 x's a week. We perform at the winter and spring concerts. All students that successful auditioned for Select Singers should sign up the first week of school for this Flex option. Singers will be reminded to sign up using the Google Form.

Chamber Choir: This group will selected out of the best singers in the school traveling to Europe. They only sing a cappella music and the most difficult level. They will perform at the Winter and Spring concerts as well as during our trip to Europe. We will meet after school one night a week.

Grading Policy

Choir is a performance class that includes rehearsals, sectionals, and performances, during and after school hours. Singers will be graded on a numerical system. This numerical grading system enables the director to grade students on an objective basis. This system will be reviewed each year and revised as necessary. If you have any questions about your child's individual circumstances, please feel free to contact Mr. Brunner.

Final Marking Period Grades will be based on the following categories:

- Class attendance
- Participation
 - Students will receive points based upon participation, promptness, preparation and behavior. Points will be deducted for being late to rehearsal, not having music, disrupting class, or not having a pencil.
- Singing tests
 - Singing tests will take place during rehearsals in small groups or one on one with Mr.
 Brunner
 - Students will have approx. 1 Playing Test during each marking period and we will be evaluating whether or not you know the music
- Written/Miscellaneous Assignments
 - o Students will be given rudiments quizzes and writing prompts throughout the year.
- Performances
 - Students are expected to participate in all performances. Absences will require notifications to Mr. Brunner and make up work will be assigned.

Choir Expectations and Procedures

Choir Participation Policy

All students are expected to be actively involved during choir rehearsals. This means singing, staying on task, having all needed materials, demonstrating effort to improve yourself, your section, and the choir.

Music Folder Responsibilities

Students will be given a numbered folder of choir music at the beginning of the semester. Students are responsible for their folder and its contents. There will be graded folder checks once a marking period.

Students will be expected to pay for a lost or damaged folder or music. Music may only be written on in pencil and folders will not be accepted if they are extremely damaged or decorated in any way such as with stickers or other materials. Students who choose to purchase their own folders, will be given music and are responsible for their music. Folders will be handed out to students who don't buy their own, but must be returned.

Music

Each student will be provided with music. Students must keep the music in good condition and turn it in when requested. Students should only mark music with a pencil.

Concert Attire

All students will be provided with school-owned concert attire. They are to be taken care of properly and **are** required to be dry-cleaned before they are returned at the end of the year. Any student who does not care for their uniform as such will be billed appropriately.

Gentlemen will be issued a suit coat, pants, and bow tie, but will be responsible for their own white shirt, black shoes and socks. Ladies will be issued a black concert dress. Black, closed-toe dress shoes and white pearls are required.

Section Leaders

Students may run to be section leaders of the Soprano, Alto, Tenor, and Bass for the entire school year. As a section leader you are responsible for keeping order, taking attendance, running warm-ups, and running sectionals. As a section leader you will be able to meet with Mr. Brunner to discuss any ideas or concerns about the choir.

I put a number of practice tracks on my website. I also encourage listening to pieces we are singing via Youtube.com or other websites. If you are interested in private lessons, I do maintain a list of teachers in the area. Please contact me if you are interested.
