

- Chromebook stays at school.




Examples of Billable Damage

Attendance Process

- When a student is absent...
 - Send a note or e-mail to the school within 72 hours.
 - E-mail attendanceMSW@boyertownasd.org
 - A day will be marked as "unlawful" if a note is not submitted within the 72 hour window.





Attendance Process




- 3 "unlawful" absences will result in a meeting being scheduled to create a Student Attendance Improvement Plan (SAIC).
- Referral to the Advancing Student Attendance Program (ASAP) may take place.
- 6 "unlawful" absences will result in a citation for truancy being filed with the Magisterial District Justice (MDJ).

Cell Phones



- Must be kept in lockers during the school day.
- If a student needs to make a phone call during the school day, they can use the phone in Room 16/Attendance Office.
- Parents/Guardians may call the office if they need a message delivered to their child.



Vaping



- Vaping has become an increasing challenge in secondary schools.
- Zero Tolerance
 - 3 days ISS/Research project detailing dangers of vaping/\$50 fine
- All vape oil/juice will be tested for controlled substances.
 - \$10 per test 2 tests per incident THC/Opioids




