Dear Parents/Guardians,

The beginning of the 2025-2026 school year is less than a month away. It is my hope that you and your family are having an enjoyable summer.

All of the staff members at West are dedicated to providing our students with the best education possible. Our goal is to provide an environment that will be positive and supporting for all students. Our staff is well-trained, our curriculum is well-written, and we have the Board and community support to effectively educate our students. To best serve our students' needs, we assign the school counselors based on grade level. The sixth-grade counselor is Mrs. Grace Turnbull. She is your first point of contact. Do not hesitate to contact us if you have questions or concerns. We ask that you encourage your student to do his/her best in the classroom, during activities, and at home while doing homework. Your participation in the educational process is invaluable. Without your help, it is very difficult to succeed.

Effective at 4:00PM on August 8, 2025, you will be able to view your child's schedule in Infinite Campus. The schedule is organized in block format. We suggest that you review the block schedule to ensure that your child's schedule is accurate. Also, please take the time to review the schedule for the following items:

- 1. Every sixth grader should be scheduled for two periods of ELA 6 and two periods of Math 6. Additionally, sixth graders will have two periods of science or social studies every day for a semester. Students who start the year with science will complete the course in January and switch to social studies for the remainder of the year. Students who start with social studies will switch to science at the semester break.
- 2. Every sixth grader should have art, business, health, or tech ed every day for one period. They will begin the year in one of those classes and then rotate to another one once the class has been completed.
- 3. Three periods of physical education should be on the schedule as well as two periods of either Music 6 or Chorus 6. There should also be one period per cycle of REACH for the Future. Students enrolled in band, chorus, or orchestra will not have general music. Instead, they will have a study hall.
- 4. All students should be scheduled for a period of lunch each day.

If you find that the schedule does not include the above items, please call the office as soon as possible to discuss it. We want the schedules to be as accurate as possible for the beginning of school. If we made a mistake, we need to know so we can correct it before the beginning of school.

The first day of school for students is Monday, August 25, 2025. There will be several orientation programs before that for new students to our building (sixth graders as well as transfer students). The first will be held on Wednesday, August 13, 2025, from 9:00AM-11:00AM and the second on Monday, August 18, 2025, from 1:00PM-3:00PM. At this program, you will be given time to locate classrooms and practice opening lockers. A copy of the locker assignment and combination will be provided during the program. We will provide a map of the building. Bear Ambassadors will be available as guides and helpers. Teachers will not be present at these orientations.

On Wednesday August 20, 2025, we will hold the formal orientation program for sixth graders and parents/guardians. The program will begin at 6:00 PM in the auditorium. Mr. Schmaldienst and I will speak regarding different programs at the school and then you will have more time to locate classrooms and practice the locker routine.

Please note that our district continues to use Infinite Campus for our student information system. As you have done in the past, we will need you to verify all student demographic, emergency and medical information for your child before the start of the new school year through the online student data validation system. The software package also will provide you with a grade portal where you will be able to check your student's grades online at any time. You will also receive your transportation information through the portal on or around Thursday, August 14, 2025.

All sixth graders will receive a Chromebook at the beginning of the school year. District technology should be used for educational purposes only.

The activity fee of \$100 continues to be in place for students involved in certain extra-curricular activities. The fee is annual and covers all activities that your child chooses to participate in for the entire school year. A family cap of \$300 is also in place. See our webpage under the Activity/Clubs tab for more details. If your child participates in one of the activities, you will receive a letter from the activity coach or leader with specific information on how to pay the activity fee.

A weekly digital newsletter will be sent to your e-mail and Infinite Campus portal to keep you informed regarding upcoming events at Middle School West. We recommend that you take a few minutes to review the document weekly.
