9th Grade and 10th Grade Components

- Review, discuss, and explain all necessary components:
 - o Resume must be current and added to one of your presentation slides.
 - Smart Futures Activities 1-16
- Discuss the relationship between the components and how the results of one may or may not have influenced your decisions with class choice, future job shadow, part-time work, etc.
- Creation and updates to your resume.

11th Grade Component – The Job Shadow Experience

• Discuss and explain your job shadow experience and how it relates to your post-secondary plans (workforce, school, military, etc.).

11th Grade Component – Financial Literacy Lessons

• Reflect upon and discuss how the financial literacy lessons affected your future plans and goals (Completed in 11th grade).

Smart Futures Activities & Skills

- Completion of Activities 1-16
- Completion of the Skills (Attempted, not required to "pass")
 - Internet Basics, Using Email, Social Media, Information Literacy, Career Search Skills, Your Digital Footprint

Personal Reflection

- Your own personal reflections, what you have learned about yourself, and your personal growth should be evident throughout the presentation.
- This could include, but is not limited to:
 - How your career paths have changed or stayed the same through the process and why.
 - What you discovered as strengths/needs about yourself throughout the career portfolio process.
 - How the portfolio process influenced your choices in the course/elective selection process for classes at BASH and/or part-time job employment.

Visual Aids & Professionalism

- The use of technology is expected for the visual aids (Google Slides)
- If you choose to imbed a video in your presentation, be sure the video does not monopolize the presentation. A video should add or enhance the presentation, not take the place of the presentation.
- You should be professional in your: dress, mannerisms, demeanors, and language.
- You MUST bring your laptop to your presentation.
- You must embed your resume into your presentation.
