- **STUDENTS WHO HAVE OBLIGATIONS MAY NOT PURCHASE A PERMIT**
- **PARKING PERMIT FEE IS \$100.00 AND WILL NOT BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON**
- **School Parking is only available for students who are Seniors and eligible Juniors as long as parking spaces are available.**
- **One Parking Hang Tag will be issued per approved application, NO additional Hang Tags are available.**
- **All information must be completed and be legible or the application will be returned.**
- **Hang tag will not be issued without a valid driver's license.**

BASH PARKING/DRIVING REGULATIONS

Driving to BASH is a privilege, not a right. The following rules as well as those in the Student Handbook must be observed when driving on school property. Failure to abide by these rules will result in a parking citation as well as loss of parking privileges for up to 45 days or longer for repeat offenses. This is at the discretion of the grade level principal.

- Any student who wants to drive to BASH in a private vehicle must have a completed Parking Permit Application with an assigned PERMIT HANG TAG.
- Parking permits are non-transferable. YOU MAY NOT SELL OR ALLOW ANYONE TO BORROW YOUR PERMIT. IF THIS OCCURS YOUR PARKING PRIVILEGES WILL BE REVOKED.
- Students must register all vehicles that they intend to park on school property and they must be family owned.
- Students are to use the Montgomery Avenue entrance to enter and exit ALL student parking areas. NO students shall enter the parking areas via North Monroe Street.
- Students are not permitted to drive through the BUS loop, the pick-up/drop-off area OR the faculty parking areas unless assigned to park in that location.
- Students are to park only in the assigned Student parking lots, either the North Upper, North Lower or Bear Stadium lots.
- Handicapped spaces are only available to students who produce a medical note stating the necessity of this request and currently hold a BASH parking tag.
- Students must display the assigned parking hang tag on their rearview mirror so that it can be read from outside the vehicle at all times when parked on school grounds.
- Vehicles must be parked within a parking space, NO diagonal parking or parking in grass areas.
- Vehicles are not to be operated during school hours (7:40-2:48) unless granted permission by an administrator.
- Vehicles must be driven in a proper, safe manner, following all traffic patterns on school grounds. CARELESS DRIVING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! The speed limit on BASH property is 10 miles per hour.
- NO Parking or Driving on any grass areas on BASH property.
- Loitering in vehicles parked on BASH property is prohibited as well as the use of sound amplification devices.
- There shall be no passing at any time on school property.
- School authorities have the right to search a student's vehicle if reasonable suspicion exists.
- Any incident of Reckless or Careless Driving will be referred to the police for disposition and will also result in school discipline.
- Any Parking Citation issued to a student shall be PAID within 10 days or loss of privileges will result as well as school discipline.
- The school **WILL NOT** be held liable for any thefts or damage to vehicles parked or operated on BASH property. Any incidents of this nature must be handled by the individual(s) and/or reported to the local police department as well as BASH Security.
