Gilbertsville Elementary General Supply List

Parents and Guardians,

The list below is general supplies for students in grades K-5. This is a list of typical supplies used in every grade level. Please know that additional items may be needed based on your child's age or classroom needs. Classroom teachers will be reaching out once class lists are finalized and publicized in early August.

Kindergarten

- A pair of headphones labeled in a gallon size Ziploc bag (no earbuds)
- A spill-proof water bottle
- A container of playdoh
- A container of Clorox wipes (AM Class)
- A box of tissues (AM Class)
- A pump top bottle of hand soap (PM Class)
- A pump top bottle of hand sanitizer (PM Class)

1st Grade

- 12 sharpened Ticonderoga Pencils
- 1 large eraser
- 4 glue sticks
- 4 BLACK skinny Dry erase markers
- 1 PRIMARY WRITING JOURNAL (top half blank for drawing, bottom half with solid and dotted lines-- primary ruling)
- A pair of headphones labeled-- NOT EARBUDS-- please practice for independent use
- A spill-proof water bottle
- Student scissors
- Roll of white paper towels
- Kid sized sock to be used as an eraser
- Art Smock-- Please use an ADULT OVERSIZED t-shirt
- Clorox wipes
- Tissues
- A pump top bottle of hand sanitizer

2nd Grade

- Pencil box (approx. 8 ½ X 5 ½)
- 1 Dozen #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- Erasers
- Personal Pencil Sharpener



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- 5 different colored plastic pocket folders (red, orange, green, yellow, & blue,)
- 10 or more whiteboard markers
- Whiteboard & Whiteboard eraser/sock
- 2 Marbled Wide-ruled Composition Books
- 2 packs of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- Colored pencils
- Markers
- Student scissors
- 6 Glue sticks
- **1 pair of headphones or earbuds** in a gallon Ziploc bag labeled with first & last name
- Spill-proof water bottle
- 1 Box of tissues
- 1 Roll of Paper Towels
- Art shirt/Oversized T-shirt in a gallon Ziploc bag labeled with name

3rd Grade- This is a generic list for third grade- each teacher will add supplies needed for their specific classroom in their welcome back letter, teacher website, and/or during Meet the Teacher Night

- 4 Low odor black dry erase marker (Expo brand preferred)
- 3 Black and white Marbled Composition notebooks - wide ruled
- 6 different colored plastic 2 pocket folders: red, orange, yellow, green blue, purple (no prongs)
- 1 three-pack Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pair of headphones or earbuds in a ziploc bag labeled with your child's names
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of Clorox wipes

4th Grade

- (1) pencil **zipper** bag (Please do not send in plastic supply bins)
- (2) packs of 3" by 3" 3M Post-It Notes in bright colors
- (1) black sharpie marker
- (1) package of 8-12 sharpened colored pencils
- (1) individual white board
- (4) thin fine point dry-erase markers
- (1) whiteboard eraser (small)
- (1) thin highlighter with a clip on cap (if possible)
- (3) hard bound marble composition books (no shiny or metallic covers, please)
- (2) pairs of earbuds in Ziploc bags labeled with name (Please do not send in large earphones due to storage limitations)
- (2) two-gallon Ziploc bags (no need to label)
- (1) water bottle with name clearly labeled (no twist-off caps, please)
- (2-3) fiction and nonfiction books for independent reading



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- multiplication and division flash cards (can be purchased at dollar stores)
- (2) boxes tissues
- (1) package of #2 Pencils pre-sharpened pencils with eraser (Ticonderoga and Dixon are our favorite brands)
- (1) personal pencil sharpener
- (2) large glue sticks
- (1) small pair student scissors
- folders with two pockets - label first and last name on front with subject ([Mead plastic five star folders](#) hold up the best!)
 - Blue - Math
 - Yellow - Social Studies/Science
 - Red - Reading
 - Green - Writing
 - Purple - Cursive
 - Orange - Word Study

5th Grade

- Pencil box/pouch
- #2 Pencils and Erasers
- Personal pencil sharpener
- Crayons-Box of 8 or more crayons/colored pencils
- Glue stick and Elmer's Glue
- Student scissors
- Sticky note pad
- White board/White board markers/sock for eraser
- Composition/Lined Notebook book
- Earbuds
- Water bottle
