



BASH School Security

The safety & security of Boyertown Area Senior High (BASH) students and staff is our single greatest priority. Provided below are some of the proactive measures taken at BASH to ensure everyone's safety as parent(s)/guardian(s), community members, and visitors enter our building throughout the course of the school day.

When you ring the door buzzer to request permission to access the BASH campus/building/main office:

- Be prepared to identify yourself
- Be prepared to remove hats and/or sunglasses
- Be prepared to identify your child's name (if applicable)
- Be prepared to indicate the purpose for your visit

Once you are granted permission to enter the BASH Main Office:

- You may be greeted by an APC Security Agent now on staff at BASH
- Have a valid state issued Operator's license or ID ready, this is needed for access to our campus/building as well as track you during your visit
- ID will also be used to verify that you are a listed contact for the student you are here in reference to. This is also necessary if you are here to drop off an item or speak to Attendance or other Administration personnel
- An ID badge will be generated and must be worn visibly while visiting the BASH campus/building
- Please note that all items/packages being left for a BASH student will be subject to search. Please be prepared to complete the available form to attach to that package
