

2019 Boyertown Summer School/ Credit Recovery Information

For students who did not earn a passing grade in a course (therefore did not earn a credit), but did receive the teacher's recommendation for summer school/ credit recovery, Boyertown Area School District (BASD) offers two ways that students can recoup this credit. Whichever route the student and his or her family decide take, it is **imperative** that the student and family work with their respective school counselor and/or administrator on this decision and receive appropriate approval.

Option 1- Boyertown Area Summer School (for Math and Career Portfolio only)

During the month of July, Summer School math classes are held at Boyertown Area Senior High for students in grades 9-12 who received teacher recommendation to recover a credit. Students will be under the direction of a certified full-time math teacher and will be using modules from Khan Academy to complete their coursework. Students will be able to work with the teacher to reinforce skills, ask questions, and review their work. Once a student successfully completes all required learning modules, then he or she will be allowed to stop coming in to class and will receive their math credit. It is strongly recommended that if a student needs to recover a credit in math, they sign up for this option due to the teacher support he or she will receive.

Option 2- On-Line Credit Recovery- Educere (for all Core Classes)

The other option that pre-approved students may use to recover credits is to take an on-line credit recovery course through Educere. BASD has partnered with Educere due to their experience, accessibility, and on-line support offered to our students.

Students who sign up for an Educere course will be required to register for their course independently between June 1-June 28. Current 12th graders may sign-up starting May 23 with administrative approval. All course work **MUST** be completed by August 11, 11:59PM. At this time, the course will close, all incomplete assignments will be given a zero and the final grade will be calculated. On-line teacher support is available at convenient hours throughout the summer, but face to face support from BASD staff will not be available. Click [HERE](#) to register for on-line high school classes. It may take 3-5 days to gain access to the course, so be sure to plan your registration time wisely.

Students and families will be responsible for securing a computer and internet connectivity. A Learning Coach from Educere will be provided to serve as the point of contact to help students navigate the system and any issues that might arise. Payment is due at the time of registration through the on-line system. Boyertown does not collect any monies for sign up for the Option 2, online credit recovery.
