**REGULATIONS:**

- All school rules and regulations will be strictly enforced including the **Senior High dress code**.
- Students who violate these rules or who are in any way disruptive to the class or school will be dropped from the program with **loss of credit and tuition**.

**ATTENDANCE AND GRADES:**

- Students are expected to attend summer school daily.
- Any student who misses the equivalent of more than one class period (2 hours) will be dropped from the program with **loss of credit and tuition**.
- Students are expected to be on time for all classes.
- An accumulation of two hours or a total of four instances of tardiness will result in a student being dropped from the course with **loss of credit and tuition**.

Students **will be expected to meet minimum teacher established objectives in each course to pass**. Various evaluative techniques will be used to measure student progress; however, failure to meet minimum academic expectations will result in course failure and **loss of credit and tuition**.
