

Grab-n-Go Meal Distribution Announcements

The Grab-n-Go meal package for Wednesday, November 18, 2020 will include lunch meals for the early dismissal days on Monday and Tuesday, November 23 and 24, 2020. Meals will not be served in school or sent home with students. Instead, these meals will be included in the Grab-n-Go meal package.

On Wednesday, November 18, meals will be distributed as follows:

In-person elementary students will receive 5 breakfast meals and 3 lunch meals for Wednesday, November 18 and Monday and Tuesday, November 23 and 24. (Lunch will be served in school on Thursday and Friday, November 19 and 20.)

Secondary Group A students will receive 5 breakfast meals and 5 lunch meals for Wednesday, November 18 to Tuesday, November 24.

Secondary Group B students will receive 5 breakfast meals and 3 lunch meals for Wednesday, November 18 and Monday and Tuesday, November 23 and 24. (Lunch will be served in school on Thursday and Friday, November 19 and 20.)

Kindergarten, full virtual, BOL and non-enrolled children 2-18 years old will receive 5 breakfast meals and 5 lunch meals for Wednesday, November 18 to Tuesday, November 24.

Due to colder temperatures, and for the safety of our staff, we have made the following changes to pick-up locations:

Gilbertsville Elementary	Door 2 – Band Practice Entrance
New Hanover-Upper Frederick Elementary	Main Entrance
Washington Elementary	Door 12 - Gym Doors by Soccer Fields

All other locations will remain the same.
