BASD Virtual Academy Planning and Implementation



BASD recognizes that families and students often seek an educational format that is more flexible yet maintains a high level of rigor with a strong connection to the school community. The purpose of the BASD Virtual Academy program is to provide a virtual learning mode to our BASD students closely aligned to our district vision and in-person educational goals. This revised virtual model replaces BOL and serves as a viable alternative for Cyber Charter Programs.

How is BASD Virtual Academy different from the 2020-2021 BASD Virtual Model?

- Teachers will be specifically designated as virtual teachers. Teachers will not be teaching both in-person and virtual students at the same time.
- The instruction will be asynchronous with optional synchronous sessions.
- Students will be able to create their own daily work schedule and pacing.
- Families will need to follow a registration process to enroll students in our BASD Virtual Academy. A part of this process will include a discussion with building-level administration, the school counselor, and/or case manager.
- New enrollments will only occur at designated transitions such as the quarter/trimester change. Continued enrollment in the BASD Virtual Academy requires evidence of active participation and academic progress.

- **Elementary- 47**
- **Middle School- 48**
- **BASH- 105**

Total BASD Virtual Academy Enrollment- 200

As of 7/20/21:

- At least 78 students who were attending outside cyber institutions have re-enrolled back in BASD.
- Of those 78 students who have re-enrolled back in BASD, 11 of those students have IEPs.
- Our registration office is processing new enrollments and re-enrollments to BASD every day. This number is 504 students.
- The total amount of students to re-enroll from an outside cyber institution is predicted to increase.

Elementary BASD Virtual Academy Model

- Lower than expected enrollment (47 students)
- BASD will be partnering with Accelerate Education to offer a suite of digital curriculum and tools for the upcoming academic year
- Two **BASD** teachers will facilitate the learning experience in the platform across grades 1 through 5 while students complete work asynchronously with flexible scheduling and pacing
- Some synchronous sessions will be scheduled for intervention and assessment on a student-by-student basis. BASD Virtual elementary students will continue to have access to BASD supports and extra-curricular activities. - We will continue to monitor our virtual numbers closely

Secondary BASD Virtual Academy Model

- Due to the enrollment numbers, most core classes (English, Math, Social Studies, & Science) and some electives will be built into a teacher's schedule. Teachers will have 5 in-person classes and 1 BASD Virtual class that will run asynchronously. Since it is built into the schedule, teachers will be able to utilize that virtual period to plan, provide feedback, meet with virtual students, etc.
- In areas where we are unable to build the class into a teacher's schedule, teachers will be given a stipend based upon the number of students signed up for the course. The teacher stipend is provided to go above and beyond their typical school day allowing them to plan lessons and assignments, provide feedback, and communicate with virtual students.
- At the middle level, due to the enrollment numbers, only a very limited number of classes can be built into a teacher's schedule.

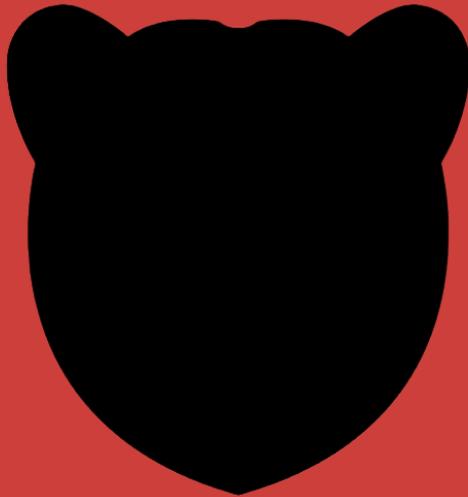

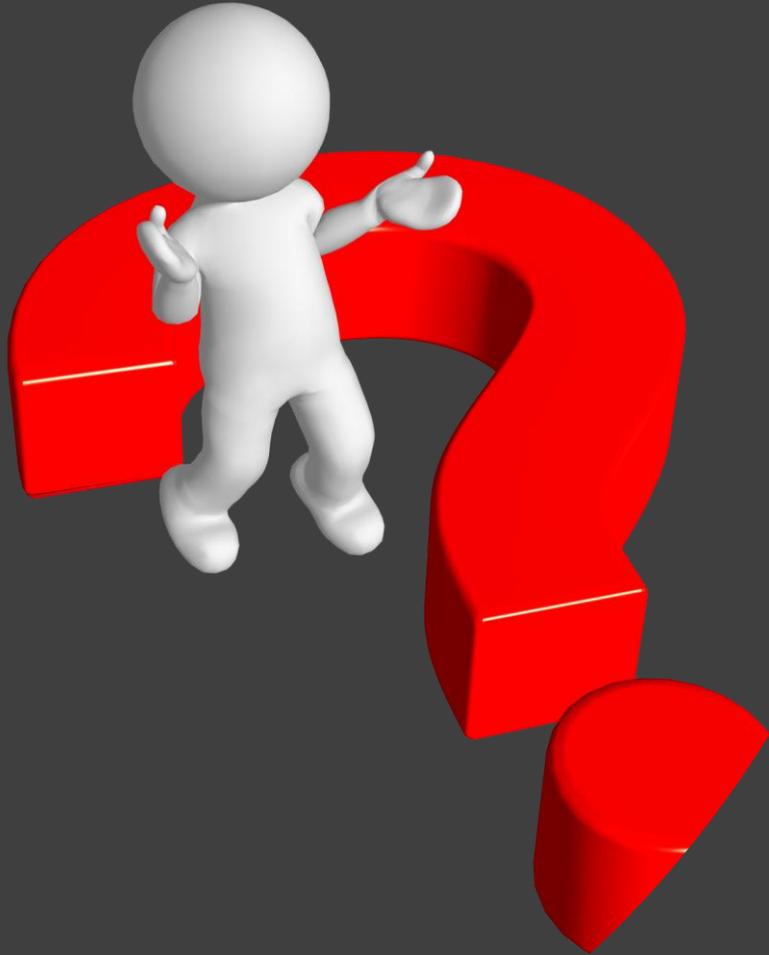
