1. Each box on the order form represents one character. (See example below)
2. Each symbol is considered one space. (Period, Comma, Dash)
3. All text is centered unless otherwise noted.
4. All text will be in all caps.
5. Write your message as you would like it to appear on the sponsor brick below.
