Dear Parent/Guardian:

This letter is being sent to all Boyertown Area Senior High (BASH) sophomore students who will be attending the Berks Career and Technology Center (BCTC). BCTC sophomore students must take five content area courses over a 4-period plus FLEX time frame:

- English Literature 10
- Math (student selected)
- Health & Physical Education II (HPE II)
- Science (Chemistry w/lab or other science)
- Modern World History 10

For this reason, all sophomore BCTC students will have their HPE II course delivered via a blended (cyber & face-to-face) platform where students will be expected to complete some work outside of traditional school hours.

All sophomore BCTC students will be assigned to a Physical Education teacher who will serve as his/her HPE II course teacher/advisor. PM BCTC students will meet with his/her HPE II course teacher during specified Flex period(s) throughout the course of the six-day cycle, while AM BCTC students will meet during 5th period upon return from BCTC.

Additionally, due to Chemistry having a lab that requires seven class periods in a six-day cycle, those sophomore BCTC students who take Chemistry will be meeting five class periods out of the six-day cycle in their Modern World History 10 course, as one of them will be their Chemistry lab period.
