



Boyertown Area School District Grab-n-Go Meal Program for School Year 2020-2021

The Boyertown Area School District Food Services Department is pleased to offer a Grab-n-Go Meal Program during the 2020-21 school year's virtual and remote learning. The USDA has extended summer waivers that allow us to provide meals free of charge to all students and children between the ages of 2 years and 18 years that *reside* in the Boyertown Area School District.

Meal Distribution Day – Wednesdays

Meal Distribution Time – 11:00am to 1:00pm

- **Families Must Sign Up to Pre-Order Meals Prior to Distribution**
 - Families must sign up **by 12:00pm the day prior to pickup** via <https://forms.gle/w5EoiWcXmTphWoBBA>
 - Families must sign up for each pick-up date so that the necessary numbers of meals can be planned and prepared. **The order form will be open starting on Thursday for the following Wednesday pick up.**
 - If your child does not have a student ID number, please provide the name and age (instead of an ID number) of all children that are receiving meals.
 - Selection of the correct grouping is important so that meals can be packaged accordingly.
 - Kindergarten students, Full Virtual students, and Community children between the age of 2 and 18 years should be identified as "Other"
- Distribution will take place at the buildings listed below unless it is determined that it is not viable to serve at all listed locations. Prior notice will be given for any changes.
- Meals may be picked up for all students in a family at one school. ***Please make sure to note which school you plan to pick up from on your order form.***

Boyertown Area Senior High – Door 18, Loading Dock
Boyertown Middle School East – Door 4
Boyertown Elementary – Student Pick up and Drop off Door
Colebrookdale Elementary – Main Entrance
Earl Elementary – Main Entrance
Gilbertsville Elementary – Door 2, Band Practice
New Hanover Elementary – Main Entrance
Washington Elementary – Door 12, Gym Doors

- While the information requested is per student/child, anyone such as a parent, grandparent, neighbor, etc. can pick up the meals on a student's/child's behalf.
- All meals distributed through the Grab-n-Go Meals Program will meet or exceed the guidelines for the National School Breakfast/Lunch Program, and will contain all components (protein, fruit, vegetable, grain and milk). Please see our menu posted on the BASD website.
