Re: Asbestos Management Plan -- Washington Elementary

Dear Parents/Guardians, Teachers, and Residents of the Boyertown Area School District:

The Boyertown Area School District is providing notification that the asbestos management plan is available for review by all interested parties. To review the asbestos management plan please contact the office of your local school and make arrangements to review the management plan in the office.

Boyertown Area School District has been diligent in removing asbestos containing materials. With each building renovation where appropriate, all detected asbestos containing building materials have been removed. At Washington Elementary all floor tile containing asbestos has been removed. There is asbestos containing materials - transite panels - in some framing for skylights in the old section of the building. This material is non-friable and poses no danger of exposure. The condition of the material is monitored by District inspections to ascertain its condition.

Over the past year building inspections were conducted by the district staff to insure all known asbestos remains non-friable. Environmental concerns within the Boyertown Area School District buildings remain the highest priority to enhance the learning environment and health and safety of our students and staff.
