The following is a summary of the July 12, 2016 Facilities Planning Committee meeting:

- 🐾 Dr. Miller, Chief Student Achievement Officer and Administrative Liaison of the Facilities Planning Committee, provided an update on Boyertown High School Project
 - Dr. Miller shared the outcome of the Monroe Street Bid Opening and shared the recommended contractor whose bid was almost \$200,000 under the project's estimated cost.
 - Dr. Miller shared a series of change orders related to work being done in the old section of the high school, fencing around athletic facilities, and additional work needed on the tennis courts.
 - Committee discussion took place regarding both items.
- 🐾 Additionally, the committee continued discussions related to the possibility of drilling a well to be used to water the high school football field and the possibility of also using well water to begin watering additional athletic fields on the high school campus.
- 🐾 Discussion also occurred related to ensuring all of our schools classrooms have an appropriate U.S. Flag as well as the Bill of Rights on display. Dr. Miller was given direction to ensure this is the case by the start of the school year.
- 🐾 Finally, discussions among the committee occurred in reference to the District's automotive fleet and how best to monitor the needs of the fleet.
- 🐾 Stakeholders provided input during the public comment period section of the meeting.
