Fals/Fall - deceive, lie, wrong

Cert/Cred - believe, sure, trust

Phob - fear

False - (adj) not real or genuine, not really what it seems to be, not true

Fallacy - (n) a wrong belief, a false or mistaken idea

Falsify - (v) to make something false, to change in order to make people believe something that is not true

Certain - (adj) not having any doubt, convinced or sure

Credulous - (adj) too ready to believe things, easily fooled or cheated

Credence - (n) belief that something is true, the quality of being believed or accepted as true or real

Credible - (adj) able to be believed, reasonable to trust or believe

Creed - (n) a statement of the basic beliefs of a religion, an idea or set of beliefs that guides actions

Phobia - (n) an extremely strong dislike or fear

Claustrophobic - (adj) a fear of being in closed or small spaces, describing a small space
