Kindergarten Registration 2020-2021

The Boyertown Area School District is announcing kindergarten registration for the 2020-2021 school year for any district resident child that meets the age requirement of 5 years of age on or prior to September 1, 2020. The portal is now open on the district website. Note that although students entering kindergarten are required to have a physical and dental examination, these exams must be completed after September 1, 2019 and no later than September 15, 2020.

Moving Over the Summer?

If you are planning to move out of our school attendance area for the next school year, please notify the school office at this time. This information will be most important as we make preparations for next school year. Also, if you or anyone you know are planning to enroll a new student in any grade for the 2020-2021 school year, please notify the school office.

Bus Deviations for 2020-2021 School Year

Please remember that if you wish to request permission for your child to ride a bus or use a bus stop other than the one assigned based on your residence, the transportation department will need your completed bus deviation form by July 1, 2020. These requests are approved on a space available basis and require four days before becoming effective. If you wait until the start of the 2020-2021 school year to request a bus deviation, there will be delays and possible denial due to the unavailability of space on the bus requested. Also please remember that the district policy regarding bus deviations does not permit more than one pick up or drop off location.
