### **Student Illness at Home:**

Parents should continue to follow BASD policy as listed in the student handbook when deciding on whether or not to send a child to school. As stated in the BASD student handbook, if your child exhibits any of the following symptoms, it is recommended that you keep your child home from school and consult with the child's primary health care provider:

1. A cough interfering with your child's sleep or ability to participate in school activities
2. A cough that is productive and has phlegm or is associated with fever or trouble breathing.



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3. Fever: A temperature equal to or greater than 100 degrees without the use of a fever reducing medication. Please note that the student's temperature should remain normal without the use of fever reducing medication for 24 hours prior to the return to school.
4. Nausea, Vomiting or diarrhea
5. Unusual skin eruptions, hives or rash.
6. Redness or drainage from the eyes.

### **Student Illness in School:**

If a student is sent to the health room during the school day and the school nurse determines that he/she needs to go home, a phone call will be placed to a parent or guardian.
