Dear Parents and Guardians,

Several weeks ago, parents were asked to commit to either in-person OR virtual learning for their children. These commitments were to remain in place through the first semester. With that in mind, we expect our in-person students to attend at NHUF on M, T, Th, and F, and virtually on Wednesday. We expect our full-time virtual students to attend five days of the school week virtually.

If parents of in-person students need their child to attend virtually for any reason on any given day, please contact the attendance office. If this request exceeds 1-2 days, please contact Mr. Rohn to discuss this need.

We respect the full array of reasons students may need to make a change to learn virtually. However, we are not allowing students to move back and forth between in-person and virtual learning as this causes disruption for the teacher, the other students, and, quite possibly, your own child.

Early Dismissal Schedule for 11/23, 11/24, and 11/25:

1. All students will be dismissed at 12:30 PM on Monday, 11/23, and Tuesday, 11/24.
 - a. AM Kindergarten dismissal is at approximately 10:25 AM. Parents who pick up at school, may pick up at this time. Bus students will arrive approximately an hour prior to the typical drop off time. Please plan to be at the stop to pick up your child.
 - b. PM Kindergarten arrival is approximately 10:25 AM. Parents may drop off at this time. Bus students will be picked up approximately 2.5 hours prior to the typical time. Please plan to have your child at the stop in time for bus pick up.
2. All students in Grades 1-5 will learn virtually through 12:30 pm on Wednesday, 11/25.
3. **There will be no lunch served on Monday, 11/23, and Tuesday, 11/24. Please send a substantial snack with your children on these days.**

Schedule for Week of 12/1-12/4:

Once we return from the Thanksgiving Holiday, all students will attend school virtually during the week on Tuesday, 12/1 thru Friday, 12/4, as follows:

1. Tuesday, 12/1, Thursday, 12/3, and Friday 12/4: Students will livestream with their teachers across the school day and follow their daily schedule as was the case when our students were attending virtually.
2. Wednesday, 12/2: Students will check in with their teachers in the morning and then follow the asynchronous plan for learning across the day as we typically do on Wednesdays.

Pennsylvanians who are returning home from other countries or states, have a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to entering the Commonwealth or quarantine for 14 days upon entry into Pennsylvania.”
