All prizes will be posted on our website www.nhufptca.org. Select the number of entries you would like to purchase for the prizes you would like to win. When you get to the "Thank you!" Page with your receipt then you are in! We will announce when we are doing the live drawing and you cross your fingers that the wheel lands on your name!

There are 2 types of raffle prizes.

1. Regular raffle prize - prizes valued at \$100+ and each entry costs \$1, winner chosen at the end of the week or if it has 1000 entries.

Each week we will have a certain number of baskets up on our website that you can purchase entries for. At the end of the week we will go live in the FB group to pick the winners (you do not need FB to be a winner). We will post in the group when new prizes are available. These prizes will be ready for pick up at the winner's earliest convenience. If the winner would like to pay for shipping we can have the prize shipped to them.

2. Flashlle prizes - prizes valued at approx \$250+, limited entries, entries cost will vary per prize

Each day (in addition to the regular prizes) we will post 2-3 Flashlles. These prizes will have a limited number of spots for purchase (50-80ish). Once the prize is sold out we will go live in the FB group to pick the winner (you do not need FB to be a winner). Most of these prizes will be shipped directly to the winner with the exception of a few prizes (These prizes will be ready for pick up at the winner's earliest convenience. If the winner would like to pay for shipping we can have the prize shipped to them).
